


CIT Disability Support Service Parents/Guardians Information 2018/2019

We would like to welcome you and your son/daughter to CIT. The CIT Disability Support Service (DSS) supports over 800 students with learning differences, health conditions and/or disabilities in all CIT campuses. College is an exciting time where students are learning to become more independent - we aim to support students with this, if needed.

DSS Supports

There are a wide range of supports at CIT for students registered with the DSS. These are confirmed with the student in their DSS needs assessment meeting. Registering with the CIT Disability Support Service (DSS)

- New students have to choose to register with the DSS even if they have declared themselves through the CAO/DARE. They should register with us as early as possible in the academic year.
- Each student will get a yellow page in their course registration packs telling them how to register with the DSS, should they decide to do so.
- There are three steps in order to fully register with the DSS. Students need to fill out the online DSS registration form (available at the end of August), submit documents to the DSS and have a needs assessment (meeting). Students are only fully registered once they have completed all steps.



Students will get an email with a time and date and they can use this to excuse themselves
from class. If they cannot make the needs assessment meeting, they should cancel or
reschedule with the DSS as soon as possible, as there can be a waiting list for appointments.

Exam deadlines

It is important new students register straight away as there are deadlines for exam supports. Bishopstown campus students must also email the Exams Office directly to request their exam supports for each exam session once they are registered with the DSS:

Student Confidentiality and your queries

Students can chose to register with the DSS at any time while they are in college. As the DSS is a confidential service - we cannot give any information about a DSS registered or nonregistered students to any third party such as their parents, lecturers, etc., without the student's consent as they are over 18.



- A student must give advance consent in writing to discuss any aspect of their DSS registration, academic progress, etc., with a third party on each occasion that a discussion takes place.
- We regularly take calls from parents/guardians about supports or difficulties that their son or daughter may be having, but we cannot disclose the details of student meetings, supports, etc. without their permission or act on the student's behalf. If a student is having a problem please encourage them to speak to their lecturer, year/course coordinator or head of department, or to speak to us in the DSS. Email is the best way to contact us dss@cit.ie
- If a student shares some information with the DSS which may be considered to put us on notice of a serious health and safety risk to student and/or other students/staff, the college has a legal duty of care to ensure that student and/or other students/staff are safe and may need to share this information. Personal data will be removed/protected from any such information that needs to be shared in so far as possible.

Contacting the DSS

We are very happy to take calls from parents who have general enquiries about the DSS but it can be difficult to reach us by telephone in September and October - these months are our busiest time as we have to meet a large number of new students.
