

Directions to Separate Centres – MTU Bishopstown Campus



To get to the Melbourn Building from the Main Campus, you can walk through the circular courtyard and go to the main entrance road to MTU as if you are leaving campus.

At the last pedestrian crossing before Melbourn Road roundabout, there are steps leading down to the Melbourn Building.



For Rooms 1, 2, 3 and Exams Meeting Room

At the bottom of the steps, take the left path – the Exam Centre is on the left.

Students who cannot manage steps must follow the pavement around to the main entrance of the Melbourn Building and follow the walkway to the left of the building.



Follow the path through the car park to the Exam Centre.


There is a wheelchair access ramp outside.

Once inside, the Exams Meeting Room is on the left – this is a smaller shared room used occasionally.

Rooms 1, 2 and 3




Turn right as you come in the door and you will face the Melbourn Exam Hall – on the left, there are double doors leading to a corridor with the 3 separate centres.



Once you are on this corridor, please wait outside your assigned room and your invigilator will meet you there.

DSS Room Directions



At the bottom of the steps to the Melbourn Building, take the right-hand path and continue following this path until you see a wheelchair access ramp.

Walk up this ramp to the DSS Room – please wait outside and your invigilator will meet you here.
