Evidence relating to **individual extenuating circumstances must be submitted in a timely manner** such that it can inform the deliberations of the relevant Module Examination Board and/or Progression and Awards Board. Therefore, evidence relating to extenuating circumstances will not normally be admitted as grounds for an assessment appeal, unless it can be shown that it was not possible to submit this evidence for consideration by the relevant Board.
