The appellant must specify clearly the grounds on which the appeal is being made. Grounds might include one or more of the following

- The examination was significantly at variance with the directed course of study;
- There were circumstances in the conduct of the examination/assessment which had a significant adverse effect on the candidate's performance;
- The candidate was seriously misdirected on the format of the examination/assessment;
- Examination regulations were not properly applied by the Examination Board;
- The Examination Board was inconsistent in applying Examination Regulations;
- Irregularities in the conduct of the examination/assessment were not taken into account by the Examination Board.
